

Timber Ridge COVID-19 Visitor Guidelines

UPDATED 11/16/21

Apostolic Christian Timber Ridge continues to support our residents' right and need for visitors during COVID-19 restrictions. We are required to keep records of who has been in our facility, so it is important that you complete a COVID screening form and sign in when you arrive.

With the exception of "large groups", visits no longer need to be prearranged.

In order to help maintain the safety of all of our residents we have the following protocols in place for visits:

SCREENING / SIGN IN

- Visitors will **self-screen** for COVID exposure and symptoms upon arrival, prior to entering the building. There is a station for this in the new entry vestibule across from the north living room.
 - Please take your own temperature and **sign in** acknowledging that you do not have any COVID-like symptoms or exposure.
- Please **DO NOT VISIT** if you are experiencing ANY illness or COVID-like symptoms or if you have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
- All visitor names will be logged in case they are needed for contact tracing purposes (per IDPH and Tazewell County Health Department).

DURING THE VISIT

- All visitors should enter and exit Timber Ridge through the new main entrance doors by the north living room.
- The use of face coverings by visitors is required within the Timber Ridge facility except when a fully vaccinated visitor is alone in a room with a fully vaccinated resident.
 - If the resident's roommate is present during the visit we ask that visitors use appropriate caution including social distancing and face coverings.
- **Visits may be conducted in any location in the building** as long as social distancing is maintained.
- If a visitor refuses to follow the facility's policies during the visit, then staff may end the visit.

LARGE GROUPS

- **Due to the continued need to maintain social distancing, prior arrangements are required in order to accommodate any "large group" functions at this time.**
 - A "large group" is defined as:
 - Any group of visitors with people from more than two different households OR
 - Any group of visitors with more than five people from the same household
 - We will try to work with your group as best we can but not all functions will be able to be accommodated due to space limitations.
 - Group activities such as singing and/or Christmas caroling should be prearranged with our activity director and will be conducted in the south courtyard with residents listening through the MPR windows.
